Where: St. Margaret's Episcopal Church

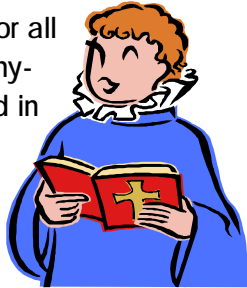
Who: All St. Margaret's Youth and children

A deadly 7.9 magnitude earthquake struck in the Ica Province south of Lima, Peru on Wednesday, August 15. The

quake caused extensive damage along the southern coast.

There have been more than 540 deaths and at least 1,500 people were injured. Over 16,000 homes are damaged or destroyed by the earthquake. More than 80,000 people are in need of assistance.

ERD is partnering with the Diocese of Peru to provide basic emergency supplies such as food, blankets, shelter support, and medicine for people left homeless. The Diocese of Peru is deeply involved in the relief and rescue efforts.

ERD is also working with church partners to assess and respond to needs in the wake of Dean, a powerful hurricane.

Our program staff have reached out to church partners in Jamaica, Belize, Haiti, the Dominican Republic, and

Mexico. Hurricane Dean has caused massive damage, killing at least twelve people. Thousands of people have been displaced. Electricity and power lines have been cut due to high winds and rain.

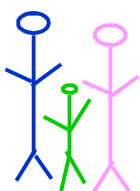
