From the rector

The traditions of this time of year are powerfully moving.

The change of liturgical season from Epiphany to Lent
becomes for me the outward and visible sign of a community
who chooses to go through life together intentionally and sacramentally.

The shift began with the annual Valentine's Luncheon.

As usual the ECW's magnificent orchestration of casseroles and pies
complimented by the clear, tender voices of Carrolton High School singers
was delightful and delicious.

Transfiguration light shone on the holy mountain
and inside St Margaret's on the Last Sunday in Epiphany
as we baptized and welcomed Faith Louise Garrett.

On Friday, just before the snows hit Carrollton,
our youth took off to go skiing in the mountains of North Carolina.
They enjoyed a fresh snowfall this year as well as the company of
youth from various other Episcopal churches staying at
Valle Crucis, even sharing Eucharist together on the last night.

St. Margaret's own version of Mardi Gras,
the Shrove Tuesday Low Country Boil,
hosted by the J2A class and their parents
and accompanied by rich classical jazz music
was a great celebration.

Ash Wednesday's solemn call to rend our hearts to God
to put the Alleluias on the shelf and
to replace "and also with you" with "and with thy spirit"
as we shift liturgically to Rite I
puts us in a reflective mode for the next 40 days and 40 nights.

There are two Lenten opportunities to reach out beyond the walls of
St. Margaret's Episcopal Church.
Both are walk/run events intended to fund the continued operation of
sister organizations committed to assisting those in need.
Both fundraising events have been marginally supported
by members of our parish in the past.

including Episcopal Charities Foundation and the Atlanta Food Bank.

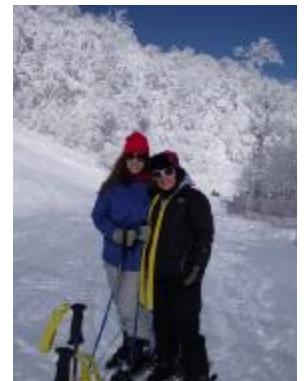
HUNGER WALK 2010
