bearing fruit in due season, with leaves that do not wither"*

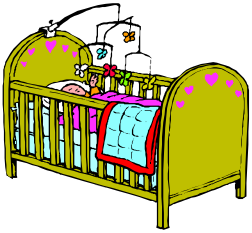
This summer has broadened my sense of God's refreshing waters:

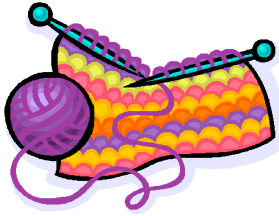

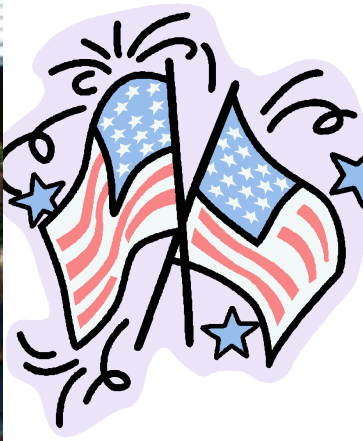
