Although our family's spiritual journey takes us to different places most Sundays, I look forward to opportunities for them to get to know you and for you to know them.

On June 13<sup>th</sup>, we will send Hazel forth to begin her time of renewal, and I will be with you full time until her return on September 23<sup>rd</sup>. Until that time, I look forward to being with you as we journey together to Easter and into Pentecost.

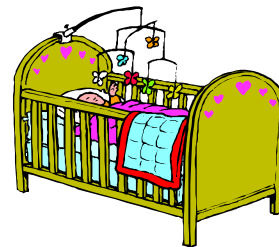

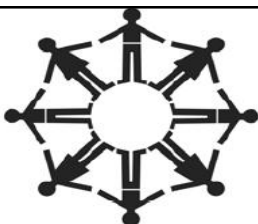

**DIOCESAN SUMMER CAMP REGISTRATION IS OPEN:** Are you thinking about sending your child away to summer camp? Have you checked out our Diocesan summer camp? Camp Mikell has been in continuous operation since 1941. It has nurtured the faith of thousands of young people in our Diocese and beyond and continues to do so to this day. This year St. Margaret's has three college age members serving on Summer Staff at Camp Mikell. Veterans Andrew Gordon and Haley Hart, returning for a second year of service, will be joined by first year staff member Sam Goodson. Several other St. Margaret's high school students volunteer as counselors for individual sessions.

Best of all, Camp Mikell is affordable -one week sessions for rising 3<sup>rd</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> graders are all around \$400 and scholarships are available for those who need financial assistance. To introduce parents and children to the camp experience, Mikell offers “Mini Camp” for 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> graders and a parent over Memorial Day weekend.
