CARROLL COUNTY HUMANE SOCIETY EMPTY PET BOWLS



Carroll County Humane Society has implemented a program - EMPTY PET

BOWLS - in order to help pet owners who are struggling to feed their animals in the current economy.

Carroll County Animal Control Shelter, with which Carroll County Humane Society is not affiliated, is seeing animals being surrendered by owners stating that they cannot afford to feed them. The pet food bank is being used to help those people keep their pets as well as assist others who approach the Carroll County Humane Society for assistance.

Donations of both dog and cat food, either dry or canned, would be greatly appreciated in order to help us assist local pet owners. A box for donations is now located in the parish hall.

GUIDE TO LENT FOR FAMILIES

The season of lent is set aside as a time to turn away from sin and deepen our relationship with God. Traditionally this is done through prayer, fasting and almsgiving.

Each year the church encourages all children to participate in a Sunday school wide collection during Lent. This year, we have chosen Kids4Peace USA as the recipient of the money collected by the children, to coordinate with the parish wide "Walk to Jerusalem" we began in February. Kids4Peace brings together 11-12 year olds from the Jerusalem area of Jewish and Muslim faith with Christians from host sites in the United States. The mission, as is evident from the organizations' name, is to promote peace and build friendships across religious and cultural divides that are so prominent in the Holy Land. K4P was founded in Jerusalem in 2001 and is now headquartered in Atlanta. Three

churches in our Diocese sponsored the second chapter of K4P in 2003. There are now chapters in Vermont, North Carolina and Boston.
