*From the rector*

"Lent is an ideal time to remember that we, in the deepest way, must learn to depend on God," Richard Rohr has written. "When are we most willing to let God into our lives? Often it is when we are most broken, when we finally admit our inadequacy to 'stand on our own.'"

Being broken, being cracked open, letting go and admitting dependency on God are often involuntary "wilderness" experiences – such as the death of a parent or the onset of illness. We can also be cracked open by life changes as the birth of a new baby, planning a wedding, changing your vocation, or finding out you're pregnant – with twins!

Even if our lives are not being turned upside down and inside out, Lent can be a time of deepening awareness of God's presence through disciplines of prayer, fasting, study and self-reflection.

The following Joyce Rupp poem has been one that I am living with this season. Enjoy.

## The Perfect Cup

it is time for me to see the flaws of myself  
and stop being alarmed

it is time for me to halt my drive for perfection  
and to accept my blemishes

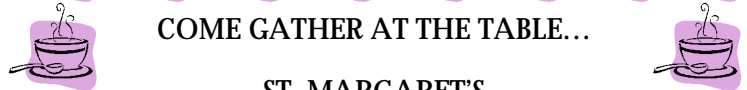
Don't throw it away!
