and sat with one another through plenary sessions

which sometimes lasted long into the night.

rich friendships had formed.

several work on the staff of dioceses around the country and

others had retired from priesthood. Two were financial wizards.

Their intriguing presentations, were intended to help us reflect on our relationships

to our health, our vocation, our finances and our health.

I'd like to share an image and a quote from the week that still resonate with me.

The first is a photograph of a naked newborn with a huge smile on his face.

His grandmother said he was 10 days old and just waking up.

He had the grin of an old, wise man with his eyes closed and head tilted.

The picture of a contented, joy filled brand new life was enough in itself

to bring tears to my eyes: but the caption put the icing on the cake.

It read "Child of God" it said.. and we gazed at it as the line from

Isaiah was spoken... "I have called you by name and you are mine."

The quote was from Oliver Wendell Holmes

"Alas for those that never sing. But die with their music in them."

Our vocation, our call – not just mine but yours as well -

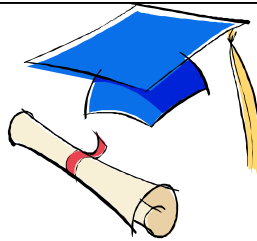
is to live boldly into the love and delight of the one who created us

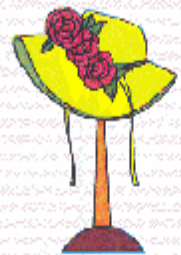
EPISCOPAL CHURCH WOMEN (ECW) LUNCH

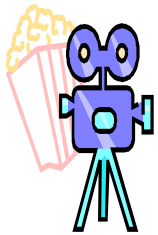
