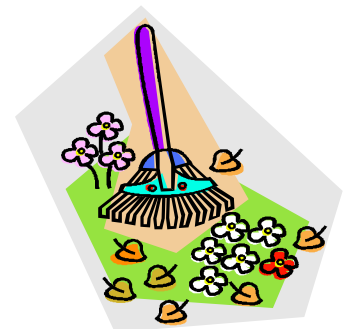

On the first Monday in August, Fred and I, along with Andra McGill, were busy trying to sort out all the donations piled up in the back of the Thrift Shop. The phone rang and it was Julie saying that Catherine had a family in her office who needed clothes for a funeral that afternoon. When the mother and her son arrived, she told us she needed clothes for her husband, herself, a teenage daughter, the nine year son with her and a son who wore a 4T. Fred got busy finding a suit, shirt and tie for the father, I scoured the children's clothing looking for something suitable for the children and Andra helped the mother.

Before long, we had clothes, and even some shoes, for the entire family. We expressed our condolences and wished them Godspeed. *And we felt good.* It reminded me of other situations where the Thrift Shop demonstrated that St. Margaret's is the "little white church that cares".

When the University put out a call for linens for the old dormitory that would be opened for Katrina refugees, Liz Key rushed to Thrift Shop and got all the sheets, towels, and pillows we had and took them to UWG. About a week later, Lynn Greene, counselor for the city schools, called to see if we had jeans and tee shirts for the children and teenagers who had fled Katrina and filtered into the city school system. We filled three big plastic tubs with all sizes of jeans and tee shirts. Lynn gave everything to the children from New Orleans.

A special education teacher approached Fred about one of her students who had no jacket during the cold winter months. Fred took several to school and the student was able to pick his favorite.

Sometimes, it may be hard to believe but that humble place called the Thrift Shop really is *Holy Ground!*
