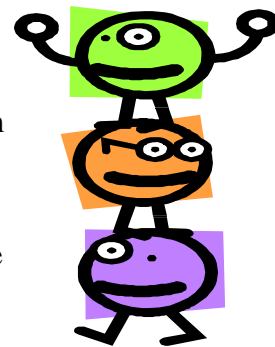


**SUNDAY SCHOOL PARENTS:**
