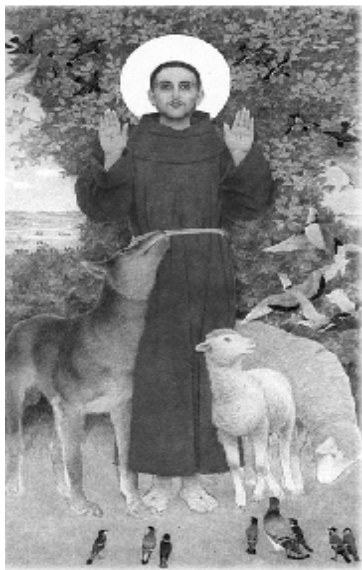


Biography of Ben Wells
